	father of the applicant applied on his behalf on	
	19.11.12 before the Director of Health Services	
	praying for compassionate appointment in his	
	favour. However, the case of the applicant was	
	rejected vide communication dated 20.04.15	
	(Annexure E) on the ground that the applicant was	
	minor at the time of death of his mother. Being	
	aggrieved with, he has filed the instant application.	
	The respondents have filed their reply wherein they	
	have submitted that as per the Labour Department	
	Notification dated 251-Emp dated 03.12.2013, the	
	dependent member should invariably have the	
	minimum age of recruitment within six months from	
	the date of death or incapacitation of the concerned	
	employee. However, as the date of death, the	
	applicant was 26.06.96 thus he would attained	
	majority i.e. 18 years on 26.06.2014, whereas his	
	mother died on 20.07.2012. Thus, as per the	
	Labour Department Notification, he will not attain	
	majority within six months. Therefore, his case was	
	rightly rejected by the respondents.
