wherein the Hon'ble High Court has held that the married daughters are also entitled to be considered for compassionate appointment subject to the fulfilment of the other conditions.

In view of the above, we remand back the instant case to the respondent no. 1 to reconsider the case of the applicant afresh by not giving effect of their earlier decision of rejection of her candidature on the ground of being married at the time of death of her father and pass a reasoned order and speaking order and communicate the same within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from the date of receipt of the order. However, we have not made any observation on the other eligibility of the applicant, the respondents to reconsider her case subject to fulfilment of her other eligibility conditions as per rules and norms.

Accordingly, the OA is disposed of.
