	<p>It appears that earlier the applicant was in the B.S.F where after being absent from 29<sup>th</sup> March, 1999 to 19<sup>th</sup> August, 1999 was dismissed from service, a fact suppressed as evident from the impugned order dated 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2004, the relevant portion of which is as under:-</p> <p><i>“Accordingly the order was passed by Shri D.C.Vajpai (IPS) the then Director General and Inspector General of Police, West Bengal. In that order his application was rejected after careful consideration.</i></p> <p><i>During the personal hearing the applicant failed to explain the suppression of his previous service in B.S.F. and dismissal from it, which it-self proves that he was aware of the fact that with his previous record of service he will not be offered service in WB.P. So he tried his best to indulge the police department to achieve his service by hook &amp; crook. With full regards to the judgement of Hon’ble W.B.A.T. dt. 19.11.2004 in personal view I found nothing new in support for his claim for service as constable in W.B.P. as the situation and circumstances in view of law is remain unchanged. Thus after careful consideration his application is rejected”.</i></p>
