As per the applicant, his father died on 22.05.2001. Thereafter, the applicant applied for compassionate appointment on 01.01.2002. However, no action has been taken by the respondent. Being aggrieved, he has filed the instant application. In the meantime, he had only filed one application on 31.10.2017. Heard the counsel for the applicant. It is settled principles of law that the compassionate appointment is granted to the dependent of the deceased employee to overcome the sudden financial crisis occurred due to sudden demise of the only bread earner. In the instant case, the applicant has approached this Tribunal after 18 years from the date of death of the deceased employee. Therefore, the application is hopelessly barred by limitation. In view of the above, the application is dismissed being barred</i></p>
