The contention of the applicant is that he got promotion to the post of UDC on the basis of G.O. dated September 16, 2004 (Annexure P4 to the original application), but his name was wrongly printed in the list of candidates at serial no. 156 as "Ajit Kumar Sen" instead of "Sujit Kumar Sen". The further contention of the applicant is that he made representation for correction of his name in the promotional list through proper channel on October 12, 2004 which was forwarded by District Controller of Food & Supplies, Cooch Behar to

It appears from record there were correspondences between the Directorate and the Department of Food & Supplies, but no fruitful result ensued and thereby the applicant could not join in the promotional post. Ultimately, the applicant retired from service on December 31, 2014 without getting benefit of promotion to the post of UDC on the basis of G.O. dated September 16, 2004.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the background of denial of promotion to the applicant, we direct the respondent no. 2, Director, District Distribution Procurement and Supply, Department of Food & Supplies, Government of West Bengal to consider the letter sent by District Controller, Food & Supplies, Cooch Behar under Memo No. 1430(En)/DCF&S/CBR-14 dated July 24, 2014 (Annexure P12 to the original application) for giving promotion to the applicant from the date when his junior got promotion to the post of UDC and give all consequential financial benefits by passing a reasoned order within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order and to communicate the same to the applicant within a period of two weeks thereafter.
