The applicants have prayed for direction upon the respondents for release of balance amount of General Provident Fund, amount of Group Insurance and the amount of Leave Encashment of their predecessor in interest Bina Soren (Murmu) who died in harness on March 17, 2014.

One Bina Soren (Murmu), Health Supervisor attached to the office of the Respondent No. 4, Block Medical Officer of Health, Binpur Rural Hospital (Binpur-II Block), Belpahari died in harness on March 17, 2014 leaving behind her husband Monoranjan Murmu, Son Mrinal Kanti Murmu, Son Chiranjit Murmu and Married Daughter Dipannita Murmu (Soren) as legal heirs. The grievance of the applicants is that the balance amount of General Provident Fund, amount of Leave Encashment and amount of Group Insurance of

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	<p><i>the deceased Bina Soren (Murmu) have not been released in their favour till date. Mr. Mitra, the Departmental Representative of the Respondent A.G., W.B. has placed on record the document to indicate that the Senior Accounts Officer of the Principal Accountant General (A&E) W.B. has already given authorization for release of balance amount of General Provident Fund of the deceased Bina Soren (Murmu) to the tune of Rs. 4,35, 626/- on February 17, 2017. It is the duty of the Respondent No. 4, Block Medical Officer of Health, Binpur Rural Hospital (Binpur-II Block), Belpahari to ensure disbursement of the amount of General Provident Fund, amount of Leave Encashment and amount of Group Insurance to all the applicants being the legal heirs of the deceased Bina Soren (Murmu) without further delay.</i></p> <p><i>In view of our above findings, we direct the Respondent No. 4, Block Medical Officer of Health, Binpur Rural Hospital (Binpur-II Block), Belpahari to disburse the amount of General Provident Fund, amount of Leave Encashment and amount of Group Insurance of the deceased Bina Soren (Murmu) in favour of the applicants in equal share within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from the date of communication of the order, if not already disbursed.
