	Minister in- charge of the Department of Land & Land	
	Reforms, Government of West Bengal, whereby the

	in the admit cards of two Madhyamik Examinations.	
	Mr. Majumder, Ld. Counsel representing the	
	applicant submits that the representation submitted by	
	the applicant should be considered by the respondents as	
	the respondents have not yet taken any decision in	
	connection with the appointment of the applicant.	
	Mr. Banerjee , Ld. Counsel representing the	
	State Respondents has produced copy of some	
	documents wherefrom it appears that the date of birth of	
	the applicant is recorded as April 11, 1964 when he	
	appeared in the Madhyamik Examination of 1982,	
	whereas the date of birth of the applicant is recorded as	
	April 12, 1974 when he appeared in the Madhyamik	
	Examination of 1993. Mr. Banerjee further submits that	
	the applicant was found unsuitable for Government	
	service as per report of Police Verification due to	
	pendency of criminal case against the applicant.	
	The copy of the affidavit of the mother of the	
	applicant enclosed with the original application indicates	
	that the applicant appeared in the Madhyamik	
	Examination of the year 1982. Since the date of birth of

	the applicant is recorded in the certificate of the		
	Madhyamik Examination of 1982 as April 11, 1964, it is		
	difficult to accept the date of birth of the applicant as		
	April 12, 1974 as disclosed in the said affidavit by the		
	mother of the applicant. Since there is serious dispute		
	with regard to date of birth of the applicant, we cannot		
	persuade ourselves to give any direction to the State		
	Respondents to consider the representation submitted		
	by the applicant.		
	On consideration of the materials on record,		
	we find that the last communication of the applicant with		
	the State Respondents was made on February 18, 2014		
	(Annexure A-8 to the Original Application) . The applicant		
	has approached the Tribunal by filing the Original		
	Application on March 05, 2018 i.e. almost after four years		
	from the last representation made by the applicant		
	before the Respondent No. 1. In the absence of any		
	explanation of the delay of four years in approaching the		
	Tribunal by the applicant from the last representation		
	submitted by him, we are constrained to hold that the		
	present application is barred U/s. 21 of the		
	Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. In view of our above		
	findings, the Original Application is dismissed.
