interest (Rs. 26,001) as the applicant retired on 31.01.2015. The departmental representative of respondent A.G, W.B. has also produced one letter dated June 01, 2018 wherefrom it appears that the amount of Rs. 26,001/- has already been paid to the applicant by his Drawing and Disbursing Officer as the balance amount of GPF for the subscription during the period from October, 2011 to January, 2012 and interest accrued thereon.

In the above circumstances, the applicant is not entitled to get any relief in the present application.

Accordingly, the original application stands disposed of.
