Hospital under exempted category and subsequently declared as a permanent staff, has prayed for a direction upon the respondents particularly on the Director of Health Services, Government of West Bengal, Kolkata, the Respondent No.2 to constitute a Medical Board for examining her state of health as according to her she is physically incapacitated and if it is found that she is medically unfit to continue in the Government job, she may be allowed to retire and draw pension. It appears that though her daughter has filed a representation dated 04.09.2012, appearing at page No. 27 of the application, she is yet to file representation.</p> <p>Mr.S.K.Mondal, Learned Advocate for the State Respondents submits that no application for voluntary retirement has been filed by the applicant as evident from the application.</p>
