	family of the deceased employee for giving	
	compassionate appointment to the applicant. Moreover,	
	the applicant was not divorcee at the time of death of her	
	mother as pointed out by the Respondent No.2 in the	
	letter dated June 1, 2015. In view of our above findings,	
	we cannot persuade ourselves to set aside letter dated	
	June 1, 2015 issued by the Respondent No.2. Nor can we	
	persuade ourselves to give any direction to the State	
	Respondents to reconsider prayer of the applicant for	
	compassionate appointment.	
	As a result, the original application is dismissed.
