The applicant claims to have been working as Extra Temporary Barber in Bongaon Subsidiary Correctional Home in the district of North 24 Parganas with effect from April 1, 1999. The contention of the applicant is that he has been receiving monthly wages to the tune of Rs.8500/- per month. The respondent no. 3 sent one letter to the respondent no.2 on April 12, 2017 by recommending enhancement of wages of the applicant in accordance with Government orders issued on September 16, 2011 and on February 25, of 2016.
