Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we are not in a position to decide whether the applicants are entitled to get remuneration as part time casual employees in terms of Memorandum No. 7284-F(P₂)/FA/O/2M-1 dated November 27, 2017 issued by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Finance, or as full time casual employees in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal. In the absence of sufficient materials before us we are of the view that the respondent no. 1 should take a decision on verification of records whether the applicants are entitled to get remuneration as part time casual employees or as full time casual employees.

In view of our above findings, we direct the respondent no. 3, Principal Secretary the Government of West Bengal, Department of Panchayat Rural Development to consider whether the applicants are entitled to get remuneration as part time causal employee in terms of Memorandum No. 7284-F(P₂)/FA/O/2M-1 dated November 27, 2017 issued by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Finance, or as full time casual employee in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal on verification of records within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow up action, if any, within a period of 08 (eight) weeks thereafter.
