	participated in the selection process for the post of	
	Inspector of Drugs. It appears initially the name of the

	Recruitment Board owing to error in calculating the total	
	marks. The applicant made an application under the Right	
	to Information Act, 2005 and found that there were	
	mistakes in calculating the marks. The representation was	
	made before the State respondents. The submission of	
	the applicant was found to be correct and accordingly a	
	notification dated 6 th September, 2019 was issued by the	
	Additional Secretary to the Government of West Bengal,	
	being annexure "C" to the application, recommending his	
	name for the post of Inspector of Drugs. On 28 th
