Prayer has also been made upon the authorities to consider the representation dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2017. It appears from the application that the husband of the applicant had expired on 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2017 leaving behind the applicant and Atanu Das, a minor child. It has also been stated that the deceased has also left behind Dolly Das aged about 25 years and Jeet Das aged about 22 years daughter and son respectively born out of the marriage of his first wife late Joba Das. So, at present as stated in the petition, the applicant, Atanu Das, Dolly Das and Jeet Das are heirs of late Joy Das. It appears from the supplementary affidavit, the first wife of the deceased husband had expired on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2007. It also appears from the instant</p>	

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	<p>application that the marriage of the applicant with Joy Das was registered with effect from 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2011.</p> <p>Ms.R.Halder, learned advocate for the applicant submits that leave may be granted to the applicant to file comprehensive representation before the authorities for consideration.</p> <p>Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondent submits that if a representation is filed before the authorities, it will be considered in accordance with law.</p> <p>Having heard the learned advocates and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the instant application is disposed by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a representation ventilating her grievances, annexing copies of documents in support of her contentions, before the Chief Medical Officer of Health, Purulia, the respondent no.3 within four weeks along with a copy of the certified copy of this order. Copies of the said representation shall also be served on Dolly Das and Jeet Das, the private respondent nos. 5</p>
