Under the above circumstances, we direct the Respondent No. 1, Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Food and Supplies to consider whether the applicant is entitled to get enhanced monthly remuneration as full time casual employee in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums
