Roy, Learned Advocates.</p> <p>The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents for granting him enhanced remuneration in terms of the Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal.</p> <p>The contention of the applicant is that he was engaged as Casual employee (Water Carrier) in the year 1986 in the establishment of District Controller, Food and Supplies, Purulia. The further contention of the applicant is that he has been receiving monthly remuneration @ ₹ 2000/- per month. The series of representations submitted by the applicant for enhancement of remuneration have not been considered by the respondents till date and thereby the applicant has not received enhanced remuneration of casual government employee in terms of the memorandums issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal.</p>

	<p>Having heard Learned Counsel for both the parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we are not in a position to decide whether the applicant has been rendering service as a full time casual employee or as a part time casual employee, particularly when all relevant documents in this regard have not been placed before us. Accordingly, we are of the view that the Respondent No. 1 should take a decision on verification of office records whether the applicant is entitled to get enhanced monthly remuneration as full time casual employee in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal or as part time casual employee in terms of Memorandum No. Memorandum No. 7284-F(P<sub>2</sub>)/FA/O/2M-1 dated November 27, 2017 issued by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Finance within specific period of time.</p> <p>Under the above circumstances, we direct the Respondent No. 1, Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Food and Supplies to consider whether the applicant is entitled to get enhanced monthly remuneration as full time casual employee in terms of Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums</p>
