During the course of hearing, the council for the applicant has drawn our attention to the letter dated 25.09.2019(Annexure-E)/24 th April, 2020(Annexure-G) issued by the Senior Accounts Officer, Pension (IX), Indian Audit and Accounts Department (A&E), West Bengal authority along with reminder dated 22.06.2020 wherein he wrote to Inspector General of Registration & Commissioner of Stamp Revenue inter alia:- "1.Authority for Provisional Pension @Rs.17,330/- p.m. w.e.f. 01.03.2015 was issued as per sanction forwarded to this office dated 28.10.2016. It is seen from the order no.1866-FT/0/5A-07/13 Regn. Dated 26.12.2018 that a penalty of withholding 10% of pension for a period of two years has been imposed upon him. But in terms of Rule 10(3) of DCRB Rules, no recovery shall be made where the pension finally sanctioned is less than the provisional pension or the pension is reduced or withhold 10% of the pension for a period of two years, a special Govt. order in relaxation of the normal Rule may be obtained from the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department and furnished to this office.
