The applicant was engaged as Sweeper at the rate of Rs. 700/- per month with effect from April 1, 2006 by the respondent no.4, Superintendent of Police, Coochbehar. The contention of the applicant is that he is entitled to get the benefit on the basis of memorandum no. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 issued by the Department of Finance, Government of West Bengal and memorandum no. 1107-F(P) dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Department of Finance, Government of West Bengal.

Learned Counsel for the applicant contends that the applicant has already submitted one representation before the Superintendent of Police, Coochbehar, but the said representation has not been considered till date. On the other hand, Learned Counsel for the state respondents submits that the applicant is not entitled to get the benefit of
