	behalf of the applicant is that the applicant did not	
	draw any House Rent Allowance from June 20, 2002	
	to July 2014, but she has drawn House Rent	
	Allowance from the month of August 2014 to

Durgapur Sub-Divisional Hospital has intimated the		
applicant that she has overdrawn Rs. 3,77,136/- as		
House Rent Allowance during the period from June		
20, 2002 to December 2015. On consideration of the		
materials on record we find that the applicant has		
not actually drawn any House Rent Allowance during		
the period from June 20, 2002 to July 2014, but he		
has drawn House Rent Allowance from August 2014		
to December 2015. What we find from the materials		
on record is that the applicant occupied government		
quarters from the date of her joining at Durgapur on		
June 20, 2002 till the month of December 2015, while		
the husband of the applicant also occupied		
government quarters as a Doctor at Bankura.		
Mr. Ghosh, Learned Counsel representing the		
state respondents contends that the applicant is		
bound to refund the amount of House Rent Allowance

Mr. Ghosh, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents contends that the applicant is bound to refund the amount of House Rent Allowance admissible to her during the period from June 20, 2002 to December 2015 as the applicant and her husband occupied government quarters simultaneously. We are unable to accept this contention made on behalf of the state respondents that as the applicant occupied government quarters at Durgapur due to her posting as Staff Nurse in Sub-Divisional Hospital, Durgapur, while the husband of the applicant occupied government quarters as

	and Hospital at Bankura. However, it was the duty	
	of the applicant to submit declaration in the	
	prescribed format every year in the month of January	
	and in the month of July for receiving House Rent	
	Allowance from August, 2014 to December, 2015	
	when both husband and wife were occupying	
	government quarters as Government employees	
	posted in different places. Mr. Mukherjee, Learned	
	Counsel representing the applicant categorically	
	submits that the applicant has already given the	
	declaration in the prescribed format after receiving	
	intimation in this regard from the Superintendent,	
	Durgapur Sub-Divisional Hospital. The respondent,

In view of our above findings the respondent, Superintendent, Durgapur Sub-Divisional Hospital is directed to recover admissible House Rent Allowance from the salary of the applicant during the period from August 2014 to December 2015 @ Rs. 3500/-per month after adjusting the amount of money already recovered from the salary of the applicant. The said respondent is further directed to accept the declaration submitted by the applicant in the prescribed format in connection with occupation of Government quarters and drawal of House Rent Allowance. The impugned letters/notifications dated March 18, 2016, July 02, 2016, August 20, 2016 and September 14, 2016 issued by the respondent, Superintendent, Durgapur Sub-Divisional Hospital are hereby quashed. With the above direction the original application stands disposed of. Let a Plain Copy of the order be supplied to both parties.	3
