concerned, relying on the judgement passed on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 in OA 401 of 2018 (Tapas Kumar Das & Others – Versus- The State of West Bengal & Others), it is submitted that since the Tribunal had already allowed the applicants therein to participate in the selection process after condoning the age bar, appropriate order may be passed. Moreover, no writ petition was filed before the High Court challenging the said order.

Mr. Ghosh referring to the order passed in OA 237 of 2019 submits that since the question of relaxation of age has been set at rest by the order passed by the High Court on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2018 in WPST No. 53 of 2018 ( The Chairman, Public Service Commission, West Bengal –Vs-Palash Kumar Samanta & Ors) whereby the High Court had set aside the relaxation of age of the applicants by the Tribunal, no order may be passed. It is further submitted that the University/Institutions from which the applicants have obtained degree/diploma/certificate are not affiliated to the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, let there be an interim order directing the Secretary and Controller of Examination, West Bengal Health Recruitment Board, respondent no. 4 to allow the applicant to participate in the selection process for the post of Medical Technologist (Lab) Grade-III subject to
