| | The applicants have prayed for direction upon the respondents to grant them financial benefit in terms of Memorandum dated May 20, 2013 and Memorandum dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal. The contention of the applicants is that they have been working as daily rated casual worker, but they have been deprived of the financial benefits as per Government Orders issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal, inspite of recommendation of their names for the said benefits by the Principal, Extension Training Centre, Cooch Behar on May 24, 2016. Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties, we are of the view that the respondents no. 1 should considered the entitlement of the applicants to get the remuneration in terms of government orders issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of | |

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West Bengal.

Accordingly, the respondent no. 1, Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Panchayat & Rural Development is directed to consider the entitlement of the applicants to get remuneration in terms of the Memorandum No. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent Memorandum 4011-F(P) dated May 20, 2013 No. and also Memorandum No. 1107-F(P) dated February 25, 2016 issued by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal within a period of 12 (twelve weeks) from the date of communication of the order and to take necessary follow up action, if any, after giving an intimation to the applicants within a period of 4 (four) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands disposed of.
