Versus- The State of West Bengal & Others), it is submitted that since the Tribunal had already allowed the applicants therein to participate in the selection process after condoning the age bar, appropriate order may be passed. Moreover, no writ petition was filed before the High Court challenging the said order.

Mr. Ghosh referring to the order passed in OA 237 of 2019 submits that the University/Institution from which the applicant has obtained degree/diploma/certificate is not affiliated to the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, let there be an interim order directing the Secretary and Controller of Examinations, West Bengal Health Recruitment Board, respondent no. 4 to allow the applicant to participate in the selection process for the post of Medical Technologist (Lab) Grade-III subject to compliance of other formalities without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties and subject to further orders which may be passed. Let the mark sheet of the applicant be kept in a sealed cover and the result will not be published without leave of the Tribunal. It is made clear that this order will not create any right or equity in favour of the applicant.
