2012 as stated in the application. It is submitted by Mr.

two memorandums, both dated 29 th December, 2010,				
superseding all previous Government Orders relating to				
part-time teachers, had directed the authorities to				
engage part-time teachers, till they attain sixty years of				
age, the action of the college authorities in disengaging				
the applicant is illegal.				
Heard Mr. A.K. Das Sinha, learned advocate				
for the applicant. We find from the intimation dated 30 th				
July/1 st August, 2012 issued by the authorities that the				
applicant was not allowed to take classes since July, 2011.				
	For the Applicant : Mr. A.K. Das Sinha, Advocate. For the State Respondent: None. In this application the applicant, who had pursuant to competitive test was appointed as part-time Teacher of Government College of Engineering and Textile Technology, Serampore on 1st September, 2010 on a consolidated pay, has challenged the action of the respondent authorities in disengaging him and in not allowing him to take classes with effect from 1st August, 2012 as stated in the application. It is submitted by Mr. Das Sinha learned advocate for the applicant, that since two memorandums, both dated 29th December, 2010, superseding all previous Government Orders relating to part-time teachers, had directed the authorities to engage part-time teachers, till they attain sixty years of age, the action of the college authorities in disengaging the applicant is illegal. Heard Mr. A.K. Das Sinha, learned advocate for the applicant. We find from the intimation dated 30th July/1st August, 2012 issued by the authorities that the
