	In this application, the applicant, employed as				
	Medical Officer (Orthopaedic) Rampurhat Health District,				
	has challenged the notification dated 30 <sup>th</sup> January, 2015				
	issued by the Joint Secretary to the Government of West				
	Bengal transferring him to Gangarampur Sub Divisional				
	Hospital, Dakshin Dinajpur. It appears that the applicant				
	while moving the application on 19 <sup>th</sup> March, 2015 had				
	challenged the release order dated 14 <sup>th</sup> March, 2015.				
	According to the applicant since there was an untoward				
	incident on 14 <sup>th</sup> October, 2014, the transfer order was				
	issued. According to him the transfer order is				
	consequent to the disciplinary proceedings arising out of				
	the show cause dated 14 <sup>th</sup> October, 2014. According to				
	the applicant, as evident from pages 24,25 and 26 of the				
	application, he is repentant for the unfortunate incident.				
	It appears that the matter came up for hearing				
	on 8 <sup>th</sup> April, 2015 when interim order was declined on the

	and hence the order of transfer as well as the release	
	order may be set aside and quashed.	
	Mr. S. Ghosh, learned advocate appearing on	
	behalf of the respondent referring to the order of	
	transfer dated 30 <sup>th</sup> January, 2015, appearing at page 27	
	of the application submits that the transfer order is in no	
	way connected with the untoward incident. Further, after	
	transfer order was issued, interim order prayed for was	
	declined . Submission is that the order of transfer is not	
	at all connected with the show cause notice.	
	Heard Mr. Banerjee, learned advocate for the	
	applicant and Mr. Ghosh , learned advocate for the state	
	respondent. It appears from the transfer order 30 <sup>th</sup>	
	January, 2015 that the applicant was transferred from	
	Rampurhat Health District to Gangarampur Sub Divisional	
	Hospital, Dakshin Dinajpur.	
	In our view, the memorandum dated 9 <sup>th</sup>	
	November, 2011 issued by the Health Department,	
	Government of West Bengal, is a guideline regarding	
	transfer and has no statutory force. It requires to be	
	noted that transfer is an incident of service. An order	
	directing transfer should not be normally interfered with
