By filing status report on September 08, 2017, the respondent no. 5 has categorically stated that the applicant deposited Rs. 52,000/- as lump sum credit to the General Provident Fund account for the period from April 2006 to May, 2006, as subscription to the General Provident Fund for the said period was not deducted from the salary bill of the applicant. It appears from the said status report that the said amount of Rs. 52,000/- has already been disbursed in favour of the applicant along with interest amounting to Rs, 61,167/- on December 27, 2016. We do not find any other missing credit in the General Provident Fund account of the applicant. Accordingly, the applicant is not entitled to get any other relief in the present application.
