	We have heard both the parties and perused				
	the records as well as reasoned order. It is noted				
	that the mother of the applicant was a Government				
	employee at the time of death of the father of the				
	applicant who retired on 31.03.2015 and that fact				
	was suppressed by the applicant while making				
	application to the department. Moreover, the				
	applicant was one year old at the time of death of				
	his father and he approached the department after				
	attaining the majority. Since, there is a clear				
	provision in the different circulars of the labour				
	department that the department should not wait				
	long for minor applicant. Therefore, we do not find				
	any reason to entertain this application. Therefore,				
	in our considered opinion the respondent has rightly				
	rejected the claim of the applicant. Accordingly, the				
	OA is dismissed with no order as to cost.
