	It is submitted by Mr. M.N. Roy, learned advocate for the applicant that though the applicant by order dated 6 th March, 2013 was allowed the pay scale of Rs.380 – 910/- under ROPA 1981 and as the name of the applicant appears against serial no.6 at page 16 and though by order dated 15 th March, 2013 the applicant was one of the 54 petitioners designated as Fitter Mechanic as mentioned in annexure–I and was allowed scale no. 9 (Rs.380 – 910) under ROPA 1981 and though by order dated 10 th April, 2014 the applicant was given consequential relief with effect from 6 th March, 2013 and by order dated 1 st October, 2019 the

	Submission is that since the Directorate has	
	allowed the pay scale of the applicant, the Principal	
	Accountant General, West Bengal, does not have the	
	jurisdiction to withhold the same or to send for rectification.	
	Mrs. S. Agarwal, learned advocate on behalf of the	
	respondents submits that the intimation dated 12 th	
	December, 2019 issued by the Senior Accounts Officer, Pen	
	III, being Annexure "E" to the application, is just and	
	proper.	
	Mr. B. Mitra, departmental representative for the	
	Principal Accountant General, West Bengal, the respondent	
	no.5 adopts submission of Mrs. Agarwal. Further, however,	
	opposes the submission of the applicant that the Accountant	
	General, West Bengal does not have the jurisdiction to ask	
	for rectification.	
	In reply Mr. Roy submits that leave may be	
	granted to the applicant to file a representation before the	
	Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Agriculture,	
	Nabanna, Howrah, the respondent no.1 ventilating his	
	grievances.	
	Having heard learned advocates for the parties and	
	considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the	
	application is disposed of by granting liberty to applicant to	
	file a representation, annexing copies of the relevant
