Advocate.</p> <p><i>The instant application has been filed mainly challenging the charge sheet dated 03.04.2019 which has been issued to the applicant for alleged misconduct occurred during the period from 10.10.2014 to 06.04.2015. As per the applicant, he retired on 31.10.2016. However, the charge sheet has been issued on 03.04.2019 for a period which is beyond the period prescribed as per Rules i.e. 4 years. As per the counsel for the applicant, he has challenged the charge sheet on two grounds i.e. (1) no prior sanction has been accorded from the Hon'ble Governor in this regard as required under Sub Rule 10(1)(b)(i) and (ii) further alleged misconduct is beyond four years, which also in violation of sub Rule 10(b)(ii) of DCRB Rules. Therefore, he has challenged the charge sheet. However, the counsel for the respondents has prayed for some time to file reply. Reply be filed within four (04) weeks hence and rejoinder two (02) weeks thereafter. Let the matter be listed on</i></p>
