Examination without physics, but they have fulfilled educational qualifications in terms of qualifications in the above advertisement no. *R/MT/Phar/Physio./48/2/2018* which as follows : *"Qualification :* Essential : Passed Higher Secondary (10+2)Examination or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology and a two-years Diploma Course in the Laboratory Technologist recognized by the State Medical

Faculty of West Bengal under West Bengal Para Medical council, or conducted by any recognized Institution affiliated to any recognized University, or a Bachelor Degree in Laboratory Technology from anv institution/University recognized by the Government of West Bengal, or one year Diploma Course in Laboratory *Technology, where basic qualification of undergoing the* said course is B.Sc (pure/Bio) offered by the West Bengal State Medical Faculty, or by any recognized University."

Mr. K. Bose, Learned Counsel representing the applicants contends that the candidates who have obtained Bachelor Degree in Laboratory technologist from the recognised Institute are eligible to participate in the selection process even if they have passed Higher Secondary Examination without physics. Mr. S. Ghosh, Learned Counsel representing the State respondents submits that the applicants may participate in the
