He was brought under the regular establishment from Work Charged establishment after completion of 10 (ten) years of service on April 01, 2000. The further contention of the applicant is that his name appeared in the Gradation List of qualified Group 'D' and eligible Group 'C' employees under regular establishment on April 25, 2012 and on November 03, 2016, but his name was omitted from the Gradation List published by the Chief Engineer, Headquarters, Public Works (Roads) Directorate, Government of West Bengal on February 13, 2018.
