(c) An order do issue directing the respondent authorities to pay and disburse the legitimate dues i.e. GIS and Leave Encashment in favour of the applicant within a stipulated time period.

- (d) A further order do issue directing the respondent authorities to transmit records pertaining to the instant case so that conscionably justice can be done.
- (e) Any other appropriate order/orders direction/directions as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper to protect the right of the applicant and in the ends of justice.

As per the applicant, he was Charge Sheeted on 04.02.2020 and retired from service on 30.04.2020. He had filed his reply on 20.02.2020 but till date the disciplinary proceeding has not been concluded and due to this, he has not been granted provisional pension or any other retirement benefits.

During the course of the hearing, he has referred the judgment reported in (2015) 16 SCC 415, Pream Nath Bali Vs. Registrar, High Court of Delhi and another wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has held inter alia:

"28 Keeping these factors in mind, we are of

the considered opinion that every employer (whether State or private) must make endeavour conclude sincere to the departmental enquiry proceedings once initiated against the delinquent employee within a reasonable time by giving priority to such proceedings and as far as possible it should be concluded within six months as an outer limit. Where it is not possible for the employer to conclude due to certain unavoidable causes arising proceedings within the time-frame then efforts should be made to conclude within the reasonably extended period depending upon the cause and the nature of inquiry but not more than a year."

The counsel for the applicant has submitted that he should be granted the benefit of the aforesaid judgment and the respondent should be directed to conclude the disciplinary proceeding within the stipulated period of time.

The counsel for the applicant has further submitted that he has already submitted application for provisional pension on 25.08.2020 and also 09.09.2020 (Annexure C). Therefore, he has submitted that it would suffice his

In view of the above, the respondent no. 2 is directed to conclude the disciplinary proceeding within a period of 6 (six) months from the date of receipt of the order. The applicant is directed to co-operate with the respondent authority to complete the said proceeding. In the meantime, the department is directed to provide the provisional pension and other retirement benefit as per Rules within a period of 1 (one) month.

Accordingly, the original application is disposed of. No order as to cost.
