	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the

the respondent no. 3 to pass a reasoned order in connection with the promotion of the applicant. It appears from the reasoned order passed by the respondent no. 3 on November 26, 2015 (Annexure F to the original application) that the applicant did not get promotion in due time as the vigilance clearance report of the applicant was not received by the Directorate in time and thereby the applicant was deprived of the opportunity to get promotion in due time for no fault on his part. The respondent no. 3 has accepted the claim of the applicant to get promotion to the post of Grade I Typist and the matter has been referred to the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the reasoned order passed by respondent no. 3 on November 26, 2015, we are of the view that the retrospective effect of promotion cannot be given to the applicant in view of the provisions of Rule 26 of West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I. However, the applicant must be placed in the gradation list of the promotional post with effect from the date when his immediate junior got the promotion in terms of Memo No. 368/1(2)-A dated March 20, 2013. The applicant is also entitled to get notional benefit of scale of pay of the promotional post with effect from the date when his
