considering the facts and circumstances of the case, since we find that the applicant got lower pay than the private respondent no. 5 from July 1, 2009 and the anomaly continued till the retirement of the applicant on November *30, 2009, this application is disposed of by directing the* Director of Personnel & Ex-Officio Chief Engineer, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate, Kolkata, the respondent no. 2 to take necessary steps for stepping up *the pay of the applicant at par with the private respondent* no. 5 who was junior to the applicant. Thereafter, the authorities will calculate the arrear pay upon refixation if admissible, from the respective date of retirement and disburse the same to the applicant. Any amount if recovered from the applicant while disallowing the pay protection given earlier shall also be refunded to the applicant as he is now entitled to get pay protection. The entire exercise which is directed by us shall have to be completed by the respondent no. 2 within a period of twelve weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this order.
