	such benefits without any further delay".	
	It appears from the application that on 28 th	
	April, 1981 the applicant was appointed to the post of	
	Agragami in the Western Wing Civil Defence under	
	Government of West Bengal and performed his duties till	
	2005. On 31 st January, 2006 he received a warning notice	
	for unauthorised absence. Thereafter final warning notice	
	was served on the applicant for unauthorised absence on	
	2 nd August, 2011. It appears that the applicant had	
	informed the authorities that he could not resume his	
	duty from 1 st June, 2006 due to mental illness and vision	
	problem. According to the applicant he has received	
	salary till 2013 and had superannuated on 16 th January,	
	2016. Submission is in the year 2015 he was declared	
	permanently disabled by the District Hospital, Hooghly.	
	On a query, Mr. S. Banerjee the learned advocate for the	
	applicant could not answer how the applicant could retire	
	on 16 th January, 2016. It is submitted on behalf of the	
	applicant that since his family is facing financial crisis,	
	leave may be granted to file representation before the	
	authorities with all copies of documents for grant of	
	retiral benefits.
