Prayer has also been made to allow him to work as Casual Worker in the office of the District Magistrate &amp; Collector, Jalangi, Murshidabad uninterruptedly and to pay his remuneration as per memo dated 25.02.2016 which was issued by the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department, Audit Branch. It is submitted by Mr. M.N. Roy, Learned Advocate for the applicant, that in view of the modified memo and as the earlier memo dated 16.09.2011 was modified by memo dated 20.05.2013, and as the applicant is covered by the said memo and as he is engaged as Group-C staff and the period of engagement is between five to ten years he is entitled to get Rs.13500/-.
