As per the applicant, his father died on 6th March 1981, while working as Tahasil Peon. At that time, he was minor and subsequently on 1st February 1991, he made an application for the first time for compassionate appointment. However, till date no decision has been communicated to him. Being aggrieved with he has filed the instant application. Departmental Representative, however, vehemently objected on the point of maintainability of the application. It has been submitted by them that post of Tahasil Peon is not a civil post. Therefore, the applicant has no locus standi to ask for compassionate appointment or to file application before this Tribunal.
