	Bengal Health Scheme, 2008 along with interest.	
	Referring to the reply it is submitted by Mr. M.K.	
	Putatunda, learned advocate for the applicant that since	
	the applicant is a type-2 diabetic patient and as the letter	
	dated 24 th December, 2018 issued does not reflect clearly	
	under which head it has been rejected as it merely refers	
	to CL-7(1) of W.B.H.S., appropriate order may be passed	
	after setting aside the said intimation dated 24 th	
	December, 2018.	
	Ms. M. Mallick, learned advocate appearing	
	on behalf of the State respondent referring to the reply	
	submits that already a sum of Rs. 95,018/- has been	
	reimbursed and the order of rejection dated 24 th

	reimbursement has been regretted by intimation dated	
	24 th December, 2018, the relevant portion of which is as	
	under :-

	The undersigned is directed to refer to	
	his Letter no. 8M-2/H.H./Pt7/14/1555(1) dated	
	27.8.2018. on the above noted subject and to inform him	
	that the medical reimbursement claim of Smt. Gayatri	
	Paul, Family pensioner of ITI Howrah Homes, are	
	regretted under the purview of CL-7(1) of W.B.H.S.	
	The claim of Smt. Paul, Family pensioner of ITI Howrah Homes, is returned herewith in

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	Clause 7(1) of the West Bengal Health	
	Scheme, 2008 is as under :-	
	" <u>7</u> . Medical attendance and treatment as	
	an OPD (Out-patient Department) patient in a hospital –	
	(1) An employee shall be entitled to reimbursement of the	
	cost of his or his beneficiary's medical attendance and	
	treatment as an OPD patient in a hospital or institution in	
	the following cases :-	
	i)Malignant diseases,	
	ii)Tuberculosis,	
	iii)Hepatitis B/C and other liver diseases,	
	iv)Insulin-dependant diabetes,	
	v)Heart diseases,	
	vi)Neurological disorders/Cerebrovascular disorders, vii)Malignant malaria,	
	viii)Renal failure,	
	ix)Thallasaemia/Bleeding orders/Platelet disorders,	
	x)Injuries caused by accidents". (Emphasis supplied)	
	It is evident from the order dated 24 th	
	December, 2018 that it has been regretted under "CL-	
	7(1)" of West Bengal Health Scheme. It does not	

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	specifically refer to under which sub-head the claim has	
	been considered and rejected. Therefore, the intimation	
	dated 24 th December, 2018 cannot be sustained and is	
	thus set aside and quashed. Hence, the application is	
	allowed. The Secretary, Department of Technical	
	Education and Skill Development, – the respondent no. 1,	
	is directed to consider the matter afresh and shall pass a	
	reasoned order, to be communicated to the parties,	
	regarding reimbursement of the bills after scrutinising	
	the records, bills and other documents within twelve	
	weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this	
	order, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the	
	applicant or to her son Ayon Kumar Paul, who has	
	verified the original application.
