	candidates, his rank is 262. The rank of the candidate under	
	UR category in the merit list who got selected is 33. He got	
	a total marks of 70 out of 100 whereas the last selected	
	candidate under UR category got a total 81.50 marks and	
	that selected under UR category got 77. But WBHRB	
	followed no gradation system and only the names of the	
	selected candidates (vacancy wise and different reservation	
	category wise) was recommended by the Board".	
	The applicant in this application has prayed	
	for the following relief as appears from the application:	
	"(a) For direction upon the concerned respondents to

	selection procedure which should be restrained for the	
	interest of justice".	
	The grounds in the application are as follows:
