	of the applicant had expired before the death of her husband and mother-in-law had expired after the sad demise of her husband. Mr.Pahari, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that since family pension and gratuity are properties of the applicant, the applicant cannot be deprived of the same. Therefore, prayer is made for release of family pension, gratuity and provident fund along with interest.	
	Mr.A.Datta, the Departmental Representative, relying on the reply filed on behalf of the respondent no.2, submits that after the husband of the applicant had expired, the brother of the deceased had lodged an FIR before the Contai Police Station against the applicant and others under Section 306 and 34 of Indian Penal Code. Accordingly, G.R.Case was lodged vide no. 205 of 2017 corresponding to Contai Police Station Case No. 57 of 2017. The applicant was taken into custody by the police authorities and charge sheet has been filed under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code and served and the criminal case is pending which has not been stated in the application. Submission is in view of the pendency of the criminal case, the application for grant of retiral benefits
