Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we are not in a position to decide whether the applicant is entitled to get remuneration as full time causal employee in terms of memorandum no. 9008-F (P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal. In the absence of sufficient materials before us, we are of the view that the respondent no. 2 should take a decision on verification of records whether the applicant is entitled to get remuneration as full time casual employee.

In view of our above observation, we direct the respondent no. 2, Excise Commissioner, West Bengal to consider whether the applicant is entitled to get remuneration as full time casual employee in terms of memorandum no. 9008-F(P) dated September 16, 2011 and subsequent memorandums issued in this regard by the Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal on verification of records within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of
