The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents for release of dues of the applicant for the service rendered by him as Sweeper in the office of the Superintendent of JNM Hospital, Kalyani.

The applicant joined as Sweeper in the establishment of the respondent no. 3 on October 27, 1969 but he was absent from duty after two years of service. Suddenly, on March 08, 2010 he went to the office of the respondent no. 3 and wanted to report for duty. The pay slip produced by the applicant indicates that he has not drawn any amount of salary at any material point of time. We gave the applicant adequate opportunity to file supplementary application disclosing the period of absence from duty, so that appropriate direction can be given to the respondents to deal with the absence for the purpose of grant of service benefits, if any, in favour of the applicant. The initial direction was given by this Bench on July 03, 2018 and the same direction was repeated on prayer of Learned Counsel for the applicant on April 11, 2019. Unfortunately, the applicant has not yet furnished the specific period of his
