	dated 7 <sup>th</sup> February, 2014 issued by the Finance	
	Department (Audit Branch), Government of West Bengal,	
	the applicant had already attained the age of fifty years	
	and had performed more than twenty years of service	
	and thus, right has already accrued in favour of the	
	applicant under rule 75(aaa), the amended rule 75(aaaa)	
	is not applicable. Be it mentioned that a right accrued	
	cannot be divested in the manner it has been done.
