	for payment of family pension in favour of the applicant	
	and upon so doing directing the Pension Sanctioning	
	Authority to issue the family pension in favour of the	
	applicant within the time as may be specified by this	
	Learned Tribunal".	
	It appears from the application that Benoy	
	Krishna Sutradhar, Upper Division Clerk in the office of	
	Sub-Divisional Officer, Uluberia, Howrah, had	
	superannuated on 31 <sup>st</sup> January, 2007 and had drawn	
	pension thereafter. Benoy Krishna Sutradhar expired on	
	28 <sup>th</sup> October, 2015 leaving behind the present applicant,	
	as stated, the widow. It has been stated that earlier	
	Benoy Krishna Sutradhar was married to Sova Sutradhar	
	which was dissolved by a decree of divorce passed on	
	19 <sup>th</sup> November, 1979 by the learned District Judge in	
	matrimonial Suit no. 102 of 1979. Thereafter, the	
	applicant married Benoy Krishna Sutradhar on 12 <sup>th</sup> May,

	1980 which was registered before the Marriage Registrar.	
	After the death of Benoy Krishna Sutradhar, she applied	
	for family pension. At that time she came to know that	
	Sova Sutradhar, the respondent no. 6 was drawing	
	pension which according to her was illegal. Thereafter,	
	correspondences were made as evident from the	
	application and request was made to the authorities to	
	investigate the matter. It appears that the District	
	Magistrate and Collector, Howrah had issued an	
	intimation dated 7 <sup>th</sup> April, 2017 to the Principal	
	Accountant General (A & E), West Bengal, being annexure	
	'F' to the application, to which we shall refer later.	
	It is submitted by Mrs. S. Mitra, learned	
	advocate for the applicant that as marriage between Sova	
	Sutradhar and Benoy Krishna Sutradhar was dissolved in	
	1979 and as thereafter, on 12 <sup>th</sup> May, 1980, marriage	
	between the applicant and Benoy Krishna Sutradhar took	
	place and marriage certificate was given, as evident from	
	page 25 of the application, appropriate order may be	
	passed.	
	Mr. M.N. Roy, learned advocate appearing on	
	behalf of the private respondent 6, relying on the reply

	filed on behalf of the said respondent submits that as it is	
	evident from the pension payment order that Benoy	
	Krishna Sutradhar had appeared in person on 29 <sup>th</sup>	
	October, 2010 before the ATO, Serampore and had	
	declared in writing that Sova Sutradhar was his wife and	
	had nominated her regarding life time arrears of pension,	
	no order may be passed. Referring to page 13 of the reply	
	it is submitted that as Benoy Krishna Sutradhar and Sova	
	Sutradhar had declared themselves as husband and wife	
	and had put their photographs in the official document,	
	the applicant is not entitled to the orders as prayed for.	
	Referring to the intimation dated 7 <sup>th</sup> April, 2017, issued	
	by the District Magistrate and Collector, Howrah – the	
	respondent no. 2, particularly paragraph 7 thereof, it is	
	submitted that as in the nomination paper for GPF, GI	
	and death gratuity, the name of Chhabi Sutradhar , the	
	applicant herein, has been mentioned as his sister and as	
	under the provisions of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 the	
	applicant and Benoy Krishna Sutradhar are sapindas and	
	come under the degrees of prohibited relationship under	
	section 5(iv) and (v) of the Hindu Marriage Act, and as it is	
	a void marriage, the application is devoid of any

	Mr. B. Mitra, the departmental representative	
	for the Principal Accountant General (A & E) West Bengal,	
	– the respondent no. 3, submits that the District	
	Magistrate, Howrah has stopped pension to the private	
	respondent no. 6.	
	In reply Mrs. Mitra submits that since it is	
	evident from the marriage certificate that the marriage	
	between the applicant and Benoy Krishna Sutradhar took	
	place on 12 <sup>th</sup> May, 1980, appropriate order for granting	
	pension may be passed.	
	Heard learned advocates for the parties and	
	the departmental representative.	
	In the intimation dated 7 <sup>th</sup> April,2017 issued	
	by the District Magistrate and Collector, Howrah in	
	coloumn "7" it has been mentioned that "in the	
	nomination paper for G.P.F. , G.I. & Death Gratuity, the	
	name of Smt. Chhabi Sutradhar has been mentioned as	
	his sister". We find that as the applicant has been	
	mentioned as the "sister" of Benoy Krishna Sutradhar,	
	the marriage with the sister is not permissible under	
	section 5(iv) and under section 5(v) of the Act. That apart

	it is evident from the Pension Payment Order annexed to	
	the reply filed by the respondent no. 6 that on 29 <sup>th</sup>	
	October, 2010 Benoy Krishna Sutradhar had "appeared in	
	person" before the authorities and had declared Sova	
	Sutradhar as his "Wife" and had nominated her for life	
	time arrear of pension . Since the District Magistrate in	
	his intimation dated 7 <sup>th</sup> April, 2017 referring to the	
	records had mentioned that Chhabi Sutradhar, the	
	applicant, as the "sister" of late Benoy Krishna Sutradhar	
	and as the intimation dated 7 <sup>th</sup> April, 2017 has not been	
	challenged in the original application, no order can be	
	passed on this application. Hence, the application is	
	dismissed.
