	17.04.2018. In our considered opinion,	
	respondent authority has rightly applied the no	
	work no pay principle for the said period.	
	Therefore, we do not find any reason to	
	interfere with the order of D.M. & Collector,	
	Birbhum. Accordingly, both MA & OA are	
	dismissed being devoid of merit."
