c) Declare that the post mentioned in West Bengal Agricultural Services (Administrative) is to be filled only by transfer from one post to the other within the same cadre and the applicants are to be given posting on transfer to the post as per proposal sent by the Director of Agriculture & Ex-Officio Secretary, WB to the respondent No. 1 and 2.".

The matter came up for hearing on 31st January, 2019 when certain directions were issued. Thereafter the matter came up on 14th February, 2019 when it was submitted on behalf of the applicant that as the administration by order dated 31st January, 2019 had given appropriate reliefs to P.K.Mondal, the applicant no.1 was not pressing his case. A copy of the notification dated 31st January, 2019 containing the order issued in favour of the applicant No.1 filed was kept on record. On that date prayer was made to grant similar relief to the applicant no. 2 who has been recommended by the Joint Director of Agriculture (Extension) West Bengal, as evident from page 31 of the application. According to the directions, the matter has appeared today under the heading "Admission Hearing".
