Bhattacharya, Departmental Representative.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The applicants have prayed for direction upon the respondent no. 3 for release of arrears of remuneration of the applicants in terms of judgment and order passed by the Special Bench of this Tribunal on December 22, 2011 in OA 491 of 2009.</i></p> <p><i>12 (twelve) applicants claim to be Sweeper-Cum-Water Carrier in different establishments of the respondent no. 3 and his subordinate officers. It is the contention of the applicants that they have been receiving Rs. 2000/- p.m. as remuneration in terms of Memorandum issued by the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal, but they are entitled to get arrears of remuneration from the month of August 1999 in terms of the order passed by this Tribunal on December 22, 2011 in OA No. 491 of 2009 and other connected original applications. The grievance of the applicants is that they have submitted one representation before respondent no. 3 on March 26, 2018 (annexure A5 to the original</i></p>

application), but the said representation has not been considered by the said respondent till date.

Having heard Learned Counsel for the applicants and the departmental representative of the state respondents, we are of the view that the representation submitted by the applicants should be considered in accordance with law. Accordingly, the respondent no. 3, District Land & Land Reforms Officer, Cooch Behar is directed to consider the representation submitted by the applicants (Annexure A5 to the original application) in accordance with law and on the basis of documents available in the establishment of respondent no. 3 and his subordinate officers in accordance with law within a period of 16 (sixteen) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow up action within a period of 4 (four) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application is disposed of.
