	matters and on February 20, 2015 in connection with Contempt Petitions No. 462 - 463 of 2013, arising out of Civil Appeals No. 6748 - 6749 of 2013 and other connected mattes. By order dated February 20, 2015 in connection with the contempt applications, the Hon'ble Supreme Court directed the respondents to issue letter of appointments to the empanelled candidates and if appointment cannot be issued in favour of any candidate, the said candidate must be communicated the reasons for not issuing appointment letter as early as possible within a period of 45 days from the date of the order. The present applicant participated in the selection process to fill up Group-D posts as physically disabled person. The respondents checked the certificate of the applicant before issuing appointment letter and found that the applicant has 30 % physical disability and thereby appointment of the applicant was held up. The Superintending Engineer, Damodar Irrigation Circle, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate has communicated to the applicant on April 2, 2015 the reasons for not giving appointment to the applicant. The appointment of the applicant is held up and the same will be decided	3

	after receipt of necessary instruction from the higher	
	authority. On perusal of definition of "person with	
	disability" in Section 2 (t) in the "Persons with	
	Disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights	
	and Full Participation) Act, 1995, we find that "person	
	with disability" means "a person suffering from not less	
	than 40% of any disability as certified by a medical	
	authority." Since the certificate given by the applicant for	
	being recruited in the category of physically disabled	
	person indicates the percentage of physical disability as	
	only 30%, we are of the view that the applicant cannot be	
	treated as person with disability within the ambit of	
	Section 2 (t) of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal	
	Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full	
	Participation) Act, 1995. In view of our above findings	
	we are unable to intervene in the order dated April 2,	
	2015 passed by the Superintending Engineer, Damodar	
	Irrigation Circle, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate	
	(Annexure-C to the original application), which is legal,	
	valid and justified under the law. Accordingly, there is	
	justification for refusal to give appointment to the	
	applicant in Group-D post in the category of physically	
	disabled person.

	However, the State Respondents have enclosed a copy of selected panel of Group-D candidates who are placed in the roaster indicating the number of marks obtained by the said candidates. The present applicant is placed at serial no. 12 of the said roaster. It appears from the said roaster of selected candidates that the last selected candidate in the General Category obtained 82 marks and got the appointment in Group-D post, whereas the applicant who submitted application in the Category of Physically disabled person, obtained 92 marks, but did not get appointment as he was not found to be person with disability as per Section 2 (t) of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995. Since the applicant obtained higher marks than the last selected candidate belonging to General Category, we are of the view that the candidature of the applicant should be considered sympathetically for giving appointment in the General Category, if he is found to be otherwise suitable for appointment in Group-D post.
