The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to grant promotion to the applicant to the post of Supervisory Grade Typist and other ancillary reliefs.

It appears from the materials on record that the applicant joined as Typist on March 31, 1990 and got promotion to the post of Typist Grade I on February 01, 2009. The applicant retired on February 29, 2016. The contention of the applicant is that the Grade I Typists in the Directorate of Irrigation and Waterways, Government of West Bengal who were junior to the applicant in the Gradation List, got promotion to the post of Supervisory Grade Typist w.e.f. September 01, 2016 by order dated September 20, 2016 issued by Director of Personnel and Ex-Officio Chief Engineer, Irrigation and Waterways Directorate. The grievance of

| Csm | <p><i>the applicant is that he has not been granted promotion to the post of Supervisory Grade Typist while he was in service and as such the applicant has prayed for grant of promotion to the post of Supervisory Grade Typist and consequential financial benefits.</i></p> <p><i>Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we find that the applicant retired from service as Grade I Typist on February 29, 2016. The Grade I Typists who were junior to the applicant in the Gradation List while the applicant was in service, got promotion to the post of Supervisory Grade Typist long after retirement of the applicant from service and as such the applicant is not entitled to get the benefit which was given to the Grade I Typist by grant of promotion to Supervisory Grade w.e.f.
