consider the prayer of the applicant for regularisation of her absence during the period from May 28, 2019 to August 19, 2019 by grant of leave of any kind to the credit of the applicant and if no leave is available in the credit of the applicant, by grant of extra ordinary leave without pay and take necessary follow up action for release of salary for the period to which the applicant is entitled.

In view of our above findings, the respondent no. 2, Director of Land Records & Surveys and Joint Land Reforms Commissioner, West Bengal is directed to consider the prayer of the applicant for regularisation of her absence during the period from May 28, 2019 to August 19, 2019 by grant of leave as observed by us within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order and to take necessary follow up action for release of salary in favour of the applicant to which she is entitled within a period of four weeks thereafter.

With the above direction the original application is disposed of.
