	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to give compassionate appointment to the	
	applicant on setting aside the order of rejection of prayer	
	for compassionate appointment which was	
	communicated to the applicant under letter dated June	
	13, 2016 issued by the Assistant Secretary to the	
	Government of West Bengal, Department of Home	
	(Police) (Annexure-K to the original application).	
	It appears from the materials on record that one	
	Aditya Bhusan Patra died on March 18, 1995 while he	
	was working as Constable of West Bengal Police at	
	Amdangra Police Out Post under Police Station	
	Taldangra in the district of Bankura. The contention of	
	the applicant is that Aditya Bhusan Patra died leaving	
	behind his wife, 5 daughters and the applicant as son.	
	Admittedly, the applicant was four (04) years old at the	
	time of death of his father. On November 03, 2009, the

	was processed and ultimately on June 13, 2016,			
	the Assistant Secretary to the Government of West			
	Bengal, Department of Home (Police) communicated to			
	the applicant about the fact of rejection of prayer of the			
	applicant for compassionate appointment.			
	Mrs.Agarwal, Learned Counsel for the applicant			
	submits that the prayer of the applicant for			
	compassionate appointment was decided on the basis of			
	Notifications No. 251-EMP dated December 3, 2013 and			
	26-EMP dated March 01, 2016 issued by the Labour			
	Department, Government of West Bengal, though the			
	said notifications were not in force at the time of death of			
	the father of the applicant.			
	We fully agree with the submission of			
	Mrs.Agarwal that prayer of the applicants should have			
	been considered on the basis of the notifications which			
	were in force at the time of death of the father of the			
	applicant. Since the applicant submitted application after			
	fourteen (14) years of death of his father, we are			
	constrained to hold that there was no acute financial			
	crisis in the family of the deceased employee for which

	immediate financial crisis in the family of the deceased			
	employee, any eligible member of the family of the			
	deceased employee would have submitted application			
	immediately after the death of the employee, without			
	waiting for attaining majority of the minor applicant for			
	prolonged period of fourteen (14) years. The			
	presumption of not filing any application for			
	compassionate appointment by any of the dependants of			
	the deceased employee for long fourteen (14) years is			
	that no acute financial crisis was caused by the death of			
	the bread-winner of the family. In view of our above			
	findings, we cannot persuade ourselves to set aside or			
	cancel the order of rejection of prayer of the applicant for			
	compassionate appointment. The original application is,			
	thus, dismissed.
